### ANNOUNCEMENT

- ORGANISING BODY:** The Western Australian Ice Skating Association Inc
- DESCRIPTION:** The Gala is an annual Interstate Competition for Men and Ladies from Preliminary to Senior and also including Dance and Aussie Skate Free Skate Level 4, Synchronized Teams and Adults conducted in accordance with the rules of ISA.
- VENUE:** Cockburn Ice Arena, 239 Barrington Street, Bibra Lake, WA 6163
- ICE SURFACE:** The dimensions of the ice surface are 60m x 30m
- DIVISIONS:** Aussie Skate Free Skate Level 4, Preliminary, Elementary, Pre-Primary, Primary, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Senior (Ladies & Men)  
Adult Singles Bronze, Silver, Gold and Master  
Synchronized Teams – Adult, Novice, Junior and Senior

- DATES:** Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> May 2011
- TIMES:** Starting times will be advised as soon as possible following the closing date.
- DRAW:** Draws for initial Start Order will take place on **Thursday, 12th May at 5.30pm** at the rink
- ENTRIES:** **Entries must be submitted through State Associations** and will be accepted by the WAISA Competition Convenor until the closing date. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of WAISA Council but will run the risk of not being accepted & will incur a late entry fee of \$35.00. **No entries** will be accepted after the Draw.

**Withdrawals:** Refund before the draw – entry fee minus \$35.00, refund after the draw only with a medical certificate – entry fee minus \$35.00. (Refer to WAISA By-Laws)

### MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

\*Aussie Skate Free Skate Level 4 – to be eligible for this division you need to be a registered participant in the Ice Skating Australia “Aussie Skate” Program as well as a member of your State Association – please supply your Aussie Skate registration number on the entry form. If you are not a registered member you do need to register for the program – please include an additional \$66.00 for your Registration Fee along with your entry fee and WAISA will register you with Ice Skating Australia (this is a once only fee and includes your ISA Registration Fee valid until 1/1/12).

**All other skaters must be financial members of their Association and Ice Skating Australia and the membership must be valid during the full competition period.**

### Overseas entrants:

- must be financial members of an ISU member skating organization and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization, the membership must be valid during the full competition period.

### REGISTRATION:

The Official Registration Desk will be located inside the rink under the mezzanine stairs on the left hand side. Competitors must check in at least ½ hour before the start of their scheduled event.

### MUSIC:

#### **Music must:**

- be provided on Compact Disc
- contain only one track
- be marked with:
  - 1) competitor’s name
  - 2) division (eg Junior Ladies)
  - 3) program description (eg “Short Program”)
  - 4) exact running time of the music (not skating time).

**MARKING:**

Closed Marking: International Judging System for all levels.

**DETERMINATION OF RESULT:**

The International Judging System will be used for all divisions.

**TROPHIES:**

Trophies will be awarded to the first three place-getters of each singles division.

Runner up medals will be awarded to all other place-getters.

Synchronized teams will receive medals.

**THE GALA CHALLENGE TROPHY**

This Perpetual Trophy will for awarded for an outstanding performance in the Primary-Senior Singles Divisions (WA competitors only). The Trophy will be retained by WAISA and will be engraved with the winner's name and year.

**PRESENTATIONS:**

Presentations will take place as determined by the Competition Convenor.

**VIDEO RECORDING:**

Video recording of skaters in the competition may be allowed if the Application to Video Form is completed at the Registration Desk for the competition.

Flash photography is not permitted.

**TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

**AUSSIE SKATE LEVEL 4**

**PROGRAM TIME: 1.30min +/-10secs**

Camel Spin (3 revs min), Change foot upright spin (3 revs), Advanced bwd stroking (backward crossovers in figure 8 pattern), Loop jump, Waltz jump/Loop jump combination, Flip jump or Lutz jump

**PRELIMINARY LADIES AND MEN**

PROGRAM TIME 1.30min +/- 10 secs

Jumps - Max 4 jump elements

- Max 2 Jump Combinations
- A jump combination may contain only 2 jumps, a jump sequence can contain any number of jumps but only two most difficult jumps will be counted

Spins – Max 2 spins of different nature

- 1 spin combination with or without change of foot, min 4 revs in total
- 1 spin with no change of position and with our without change of foot, min 4 revs in total

Choreographed Spiral/Step sequence

- Max 1 Choreographed Spiral/Step sequence

### **ELEMENTARY LADIES AND MEN**

PROGRAM TIME 2min +/- 10 secs

Jumps - Max 4 jump elements

- Max 2 Jump Combinations
- A jump combination may contain only 2 jumps, a jump sequence can contain any number of jumps but only two most difficult jumps will be counted

Spins – Max 2 spins of different nature

- 1 spin combination with or without change of foot, min 4 revs in total
- 1 spin with no change of position and with our without change of foot, min 4 revs in total

Choreographed Spiral/Step sequence

- Max 1 Choreographed Spiral/Step sequence

### **PRE-PRIMARY LADIES AND MEN**

PROGRAM TIME 2min 30sec +/-10secs

Jumps - Max 4 jump elements

- 1 must be an axel-type jump
- Max 2 Jump Combinations
- A jump combination may contain only 2 jumps, a jump sequence can contain any number of jumps but only two most difficult jumps will be counted

Spins – Max 2 spins of different nature

- 1 spin combination with or without change of foot, min 6 revs in total
- 1 spin with no change of position and with our without change of foot, min 6 revs in total

Choreographed Spiral/Step sequence

- Max 1 Choreographed Spiral or Step sequence (fixed base value, evaluated in GOE only)
